Codes of Conduct

These codes of conduct have been developed as a guide for players, parents, coaches and managers so that the experience at Fields United can be an enjoyable and rewarding time.

The information used in these codes comes from the Australian Sports Commission and the Macarthur District Soccer Football Association Inc. The information contained in this document explains the conduct that is required of players, parents, coaches and managers as well as their duties and responsibilities while part of Fields United Soccer Club Inc. It also contains information on what to do when assistance is required or a dispute or concern arises.

Please read this document. It is expected that everyone will comply with the Codes of Conduct.

<p>Players Code of Conduct and Ethics</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be proud to represent Fields United Soccer Club Inc.• Do not argue with the referee or lines people.• Listen to your coach and attempt to do everything they ask.• Work hard to support your team mates.• Display good manners at training and games.• Do not swear, abuse or use foul language at any time.• Work hard at your game, at training and at home.• Dress appropriate for training.• Arrive at training sessions early enough to start on time.• Arrive at matches at least 30 minutes before kick off.• Arrive at all matches in correct uniform. Incorrectly dressed players will not be permitted to take the field.• Socks must be pulled up and shirts tucked in during matches.• Players guilty of misconduct at training or matches may be required to appear before the "Club" Management Committee.	<p>Parent's and Supporters Code of Conduct</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Do not criticize or enter into any discussion with the referee or lines person at matches.• Provide encouragement and support for your child and their team mates at matches but do not offer coaching advice.• Encourage your child to work hard at their game at home and at training.• Your child is required to arrive at matches at least 30 minutes before kick off time and is to remain with the team until dismissed by the team coach.• Your child is required to attend all training sessions and is required to arrive in time to prepare themselves to start at the appointed time.• If your child is unable to attend training or a match, it is the parents' responsibility to inform the Coach or Manager prior to training or the match.• Treat the opposing team and officials with respect. Fields United Sports Club is well respected within the Association and wishes to reciprocate with all Clubs.• Each team's parents will be asked to assist during the year with Duty Roster, washing of shirts and fundraising – for the benefit of your children. Please contribute generously and in the good spirit the "Club" has developed.• Parents guilty of misconduct at training or matches may be required to appear before the "Club" Management Committee.• Provide an example of sportsmanship and fair play to your children.
<p>Coaches and Managers Code of Conduct</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Do not criticize or enter into any discussion with the referee or lines person at matches.• In your coaching role, provide encouragement and support for the players in your team at training and matches.• Encourage the players in your team to work hard at their game at home and at training.• You are required to attend all training sessions in time to prepare to start at the appropriate time.• If you are unable to attend training or a match, it is your responsibility to inform all of the parents and make suitable alternative arrangements prior to training or the match.• Treat the opposing team and officials with respect. Fields United Sports Club is well respected within the Association and wishes to reciprocate with all Clubs.• Coaches and Managers guilty of misconduct at training or matches may be required to appear before the "Club" Management Committee.• Provide an example of sportsmanship and fair play to your team.
